**10/65 TO RECEIVE APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE**

Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr Camwell (Work), Cllr Lemmon, Cllr Mrs Patten

**10/66 VARIATION OF ORDER OF BUSINESS**

No variation of business was made

**10/67 MEMBERS TO DECLARE AN INTEREST.**

Cllr Silvester declared a personal interest in the agenda item relating to the request for grant funding of a Children's party, as his sons would attend the party.

**10/68 PUBLIC SPEAKING**

**a) Members of the Public**

A request was made for an extension of the speed limits on all entry points to the village, as the member of the public considered that the roads were unsuitable for the national speed limit.

**c) District Councillor**

Cllr Mrs Brown explained that the Regional Plan is still the primary legislation until the new Localism Bill becomes law and the possible implications of the new legislation.

Potholes have appeared on Grassy Lane and require attention.

Cllr Mrs Brown was asked to provide an update on the Burnaston Cross application. She stated that the Planning Inspector had rejected the application, which in turn had resulted in Severn Trent re-engaging in talks with SDDC regarding the railhead at Etwall/Egginton.

Cllr Holland requested some mechanism that would inform residents of relevant consultations sooner and more effectively.

10/74 MICKLEOVER COUNTRY PARK MATTERS

A request had been made for a grit bin on Sandpiper Lane.

The Parish Council considered the location and request.

RESOLVED: to first attempt to obtain a grit bin, free of charge, from DCC but if that was unsuccessful, to purchase a grit bin.

The location was agreed as a resident of Sandpiper Lane had agreed in writing to have the grit bin located on the edge of her garden.

10/76 BURNASTON VILLAGE MATTERS

- a) The Dee Lane sign was damaged and has been removed by SDDC. A replacement is awaited.
- b) The request for the change of the speed limits around the village was discussed  
RESOLVED: to write to DCC for traffic signs to advise motorists of the double bend on Dee Lane and of the wide bend on Findern Lane, close to the junction with Main Street.

The Risk Assessments were reviewed and no amendments were deemed necessary

10/78 PLANNING MATTERS

Applications

9 2010 0838 TP – The felling of two poplar trees protected under SDDC TPO 132 at 12 Mallard Walk, Mickleover

OBJECTIONS – the trees should be pruned not removed. TPOs were attached in order to maintain the character of the area which is being eroded by the removal of trees.

9 2010 0789 TP – The felling of 2 pine trees and pruning of a larch tree covered by SDDC TPO 132 at 16 Finch Crescent, Mickleover

OBJECTIONS as it is considered that there is nothing wrong with the trees, but it was agreed that they would benefit from pruning. A query was made as to why the District Council is making this application. The Clerk advised that SDDC was concerned that work was required to be carried out quickly and so had made the application. The cost of the work would be recharged to Redrow.

9 2010 0818 NO – The erection of a business unit, parking and service area and alterations to the existing access at Windyridge, Burton Road, Findern

OBJECTIONS as concerns surrounding the access are still strong. The Parish Council is reassured by the small number of vehicle movements but the distance from Findern Lane to the access is less than 100 metres. This will possibly mean that drivers will (dangerously) drive across the front of Findern Lane exit. It is suggested that the access is located nearer to the distribution depot.
